Hospital **\$825 - \$2,000 / day** \$24,750 - \$60,000 / month

Institution \$5,000 - \$8,000 / month

Retirement home with assistance Up to \$5,000 / month

Individual:

Cohousing Mortgage + utilities \$1,500 / month
